#### Summer sermon series explores "Prophet Margins"

#### **Annual Conference report**

On Friday and Saturday, June 3 and 4, Pastor Joel, Pastor Jeff, and Lay Member Jerry Lapham attended the 2022 West Ohio Annual Conference via Zoom.

The Conference Book of Reports contains extensive instructions for churches wishing to leave the United Methodist Church with their property under paragraph 2553 of the 2019 Discipline. Actions must be completed by the end of 2023.

Agenda Recommendation #8 contained a proposal for using paragraph 2548.2 which has no end date. The Bishop ruled it out of order because there is already a case before the Judicial Council on the subject and his ruling will go there also.

Agenda Recommendation #7, which called for "Ordination without prejudice toward sexual orientation or gender identity" was defeated.

#### Pray for VBS, July 10-14


Please keep our Monumental Vacation Bible School in your prayers. You might pray for the following aspects:

#### **BEFORE AND AFTER**



Before

One of the founders of Monroe, Nathaniel Sackett was the father of Methodism in the village of Monroe. He was a local Methodist preacher and held services in his home. As interest increased a church was formed. It was not long before a meeting house was constructed.

The congregation continued to grow and in 1860 the church needed more room. The old building was torn down and the church pictured above was constructed on the same lot. The first service in the new building was held in February 1861.

On May 10, 1969, a cloudy windy Saturday afternoon, the sky suddenly grew very dark, and the wind blasted in from the west as the rain began to pelt down, at times turning to hail. At about 4:30 p.m., a black funnel cloud appeared over Monroe.

The resulting tornado caused a lot of damage to the Monroe community. Lost was the steeple on the Monroe Methodist Church. It along with the water tower next to the church, the steeple had become a symbol for the community.
